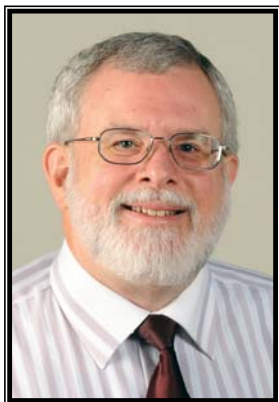


## William Hayden, *Concertmaster*

### Tampa Bay Symphony



William Hayden completed his Doctor of Arts (D.A.) degree in violin, orchestral conducting, and post-secondary music education in 1981 at Ball State University [IN] after attending The Juilliard School [NY] from 1970 to 1976 where he earned his B.M. and M.M. degrees as a student of Dorothy DeLay, Joseph Fuchs, and Aaron Rosand in violin and Paul Doktor and William Lincer in viola. He was Principal Violist of the Juilliard Pre-College Orchestra before becoming the Concertmaster of the Juilliard Repertory Orchestra and the National Orchestra of New York.

Dr. Hayden came to USF in 1989 as Associate Professor of Music after serving as Director of Strings and Orchestras at Houghton College [NY], Liberty University [VA], and the University of [Southwestern] Louisiana at Lafayette. He was a 1994 recipient of the prestigious Teaching Incentive Award of Florida's State University System for his excellence in undergraduate teaching. Appointed as Undergraduate Music Advisor in 1997, he was later selected twice for the Outstanding Undergraduate Advising Award at USF.

Bill currently carries an administrative role as the Music Admissions Coordinator, the Graduate Program Coordinator, and the Academic Advisor to approximately 475 undergraduate and graduate music majors. He is the Music Director of the Northeast Tampa Musicians, a volunteer group which performs on Thursdays in the local hospice and nursing homes. On Saturdays, he operates Terrace Violin Repair, a shop that handles sales and repairs of string instruments, bows, and accessories.
