Normally we would fill up this page with action photos of our youth and guest artists and orchestra members, but this year I think it’s important to let every one know what our plans are for our 2020–2021 season. Safety is our main concern, for our musicians, staff and you, our patrons. With respect to safety, I want to address two main areas: programming and venues.

Regarding programming, we take a cautiously optimistic view which is reflected in this brochure, meaning that we are programming chamber music selections which involve fewer musicians on stage for our Fall series. We are hoping to resume with a full orchestra for our Winter and Spring series, which will bring you *Scheherazade* in the Winter and *Pictures at an Exhibition* in the Spring. As we progress into this fall, we will continue to monitor and follow CDC and state guidelines with respect to how we hold rehearsals and how we deliver the final performance to you in the concert halls. If we find that following CDC guidelines makes it too difficult to deliver *Scheherazade* in the Winter and *Pictures at an Exhibition* in the Spring, we may replace these selections, and others, with works involving fewer players, like we are doing this Fall. Rest assured, your Maestro, Mark Sforzini, will provide brilliant selections that coincide with whatever live listening enjoyment is possible at the time!


